STAFF'S MOTION TO OPEN WORKING DOCKET

COMES NOW Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through the undersigned counsel, and files this Motion to open a working docket with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") stating the following:

- 1. The Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act ("MEEIA") is codified at Section 393.1075, RSMo (Supp. 2012).
- 2. The Commission has promulgated rules to implement MEEIA, specifically rules 4 CSR 240-3.163, 4 CSR 240-3.164, 4 CSR 240-20.093 and 4 CSR 240-20.094, each of which provides:
 - Rule Review. The commission shall complete a review of the effectiveness of this rule no later than four (4) years after the effective date of this rule and may, if it deems necessary, initiate rulemaking proceedings to revise this rule.
- 3. The above-referenced rules became effective May 30, 2011 and the four-year period following their effective date will expire May 30, 2015.

- 4. Staff recommends the Commission establish a working docket with directions for interested stakeholders to respond with comments by November 14, 2014 to the following requests:
 - a. Please comment as to the effectiveness of the MEEIA rules
 - b. Please suggest proposed changes to the MEEIA rules. These suggestions need not be in the form of a draft amendment, but should include citations to the language which would be amended if the proposed changes are effectuated.
 - c. Please comment as to any issues which should be addressed in proposed amendments to the MEEIA rules not presently included in the rules.
- 5. The Commission's establishment of a working docket will assist the Staff in developing an initial draft of proposed amendments to the MEEIA rules. These proposed amendments will facilitate future workshop discussions. A docket will also provide transparency during this process and will allow any person with an interest in this matter to view documents and submit comments.
- 6. Staff recommends the Commission provide notice of its establishment of a working docket in this matter along with the notice in Attachment A to: the parties and interveners in the various utilities' MEEIA filings, File Nos. EO-2012-0009, EO-2012-0142, EO-2014-0030 and EO-2014-0355; the Office of the Public Counsel.

WHEREFORE, Staff moves for the Commission to establish a working docket for the purposes described above, and recommends the Commission provide notice of the docket along with the collaborative notice in *Attachment A* to the entities listed in paragraph six (6) above along with any other person the Commission deems necessary.
