1. On June 23, 2023, Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc., filed an *Application and Motion for Waiver* asking the Commission to grant it a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to acquire the sewer system assets of the Village of Luray in Clark County, Missouri.
