ORDER DIRECTING STATUS UPDATE

On August 29, 2023,¹ the Commission ordered these proceedings stayed at the request of The Empire District Electric Company, d/b/a Liberty, with the agreement or non-objection of Mr. Lindsey and New-Mac Electric Cooperative, Inc. (New-Mac Electric). The stay was requested on the premise that settlement discussions were occurring with the goal of resolving Mr. Lindsey's application to change electric suppliers. The Commission ordered its Staff to provide a status update of the parties' negotiations.

On September 29, Staff filed its status report indicating that Liberty's equipment was being tested, but that Staff did not have further settlement information to report. Staff suggested that the Commission order the parties to consult with each other and that they each be ordered to directly file their own status report.

The Commission finds the request reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties shall consult with each other for the purpose of reaching settlement, in whole or in part. The Commission is willing to assist the parties in this regard

via scheduling a settlement conference, assigning a mediator, or otherwise as requested, preferably in a joint request if possible.

2. No later than November 3, 2023, Liberty, Mr. Lindsay, and New-Mac Electric shall file a status report or other appropriate pleading.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
