## STAFF RECOMMENDATION

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through the undersigned counsel, and for its *Staff Recommendation* respectfully states:

- 1. On September 27, 2023, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") filed a tariff sheet for its Weather Normalization Rider ("WNAR"), with an effective date of November 1, 2023.
- 2. The Commission subsequently issued its *Order Directing Filing* that same date, directing Staff to file its recommendation on this matter no later than October 11, 2023.
- 3. As detailed in Staff's *Memorandum*, attached and incorporated hereto as Attachment A, the purpose of Ameren Missouri's filing is to adjust revenues for differences between actual heating degree days ("AHDD") and normal heating degree days ("NHDD"). The weather normalization adjustments in dollars per hundred cubic feet ("Ccf") are calculated for each billing cycle based on the difference between the actual and the normal weather measured for each billing cycle.
- 4. Ameren Missouri's current and proposed rates under the WNAR are outlined in the table below:

Customer	Current WNAR	Proposed WNAR	Net Change
Class	(\$/Ccf)	(\$/Ccf)	(\$/Ccf)
Residential	0.0242	0.0480	0.0238

- 5. The proposed change in residential rates would see an approximately \$2.38 increase for a residential customer using 100 Ccf of natural gas in a given billing month.
- 6. After reviewing Ameren Missouri's filing, Staff recommends approval of the following tariff sheet, effective November 1, 2023:

P.S.C. MO. No. 2 2<sup>nd</sup> Revised Sheet No. 32.2 Cancelling 1<sup>st</sup> Revised Sheet No. 32.2

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends the Commission issue an order approving Second Revised Sheet No. 32.2, Cancelling First Revised Sheet No. 32.2, with an effective date of November 1, 2023.

On September 1, 2023, Ameren Missouri filed one tariff sheet in Tariff Tracking No. JG-2024-0032 for its weather normalization adjustment rider (WNAR) rate with a request for the gas rate to go into effect on November 1, 2023. On September 27, 2023, the Commission directed Staff to file a recommendation regarding the tariff sheet no later than October 11, 2023.

This is Ameren Missouri's second WNAR filing. Ameren Missouri's WNAR became effective on February 28, 2022 in Ameren Missouri's general rate case, Case No. GR-2021-0241. The purpose of the tariff is to adjust revenues for differences between actual heating degree days (AHDD) and normal heating degree days (NHDD). The weather normalization adjustments in dollars per hundred cubic feet (Ccf) are calculated for each billing cycle based on the difference between the actual and the normal weather measured for each billing cycle. Ameren Missouri's current and proposed rate is included in Table 1 below.

The proposed residential rate for the Ameren Missouri district service area will increase customer gas bills. This means a residential customer that uses 100 Ccf of natural gas in a given billing month would see an approximate \$2.38 increase in their bill due to this request.
