STAFF'S COMPLIANCE TARIFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), through counsel, and recommends that the Commission approve the proposed tariff sheets Spire Missouri, Inc. ("Spire") filed on October 4, 2023, to take effect at least 10 days after the Commission's order.

- 1. On October 4, 2023, Spire filed compliance its tariff sheet in tariff tracking number JG-2024-0045, bearing proposed effective dates of November 3, 2023. However, in a motion for expedited treatment, Spire requested effective dates of October 16, 2023.
- 2. Staff reviewed the tariff sheet and concludes that it complies with the Commission's October 4, 2023 order, as more fully detailed in Staff's Memorandum, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 3. Staff does not object to expedited treatment which provides for at least 10 days between the issue dates and the effective dates of the Commission order approving the tariff sheet.¹

WHEREFORE, Staff requests that the Commission issue an order approving Spire's proposed tariff sheets filed October 4, 2023, to take effect at least 10 days after the Commission's order.

DATE: October 11, 2023

On October 04, 2023, the Commission issued "Order Approving Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge" which authorizes:

Spire Missouri Inc., d/b/a Spire ("Spire Missouri" or "Company" or "Spire) to file a tariff sheet consistent with Staff's recommendation. The order states the following:

"The Commission Orders That:

- 1. Spire is authorized to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS) sufficient to recover ISRS revenues in the amount of \$3,448,192 for Spire East, and \$8,944,014 for Spire West, for a total increase of \$12,392,206.
- 2. The tariff sheet filed by Spire on June 20, 2023, and assigned Tariff Tracking No. YG-2023-0224, is rejected
- 3. Spire is authorized to file new tariff sheets to recover the revenue authorized in this Order."

On October 4, 2023, Spire Missouri, in response to the aforementioned Commission order, filed both a cover letter and a revised tariff page.

On October 5, 2023, the Commission issued Order Directing Filing which contains the following:

'The Commission Orders That:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation no later than October 11, 2023

STAFF'S ANALYSIS

This memo is Staff's response to Spire Missouri's responding to the aforementioned

Commission's authorization (October 4, 2023 Order) and to Spire Missouri's submission of a tariff

sheet and cover letter referenced above, filed on October 4, 2023.

In that submission, Spire Missouri filed a new tariff sheet (containing rates higher than those in

place today) in order to recover the revenue requirement recommended by Staff in its "Staff

Recommendation" of September 18, 2023. The tariff sheet is labeled "Fifth Revised Sheet No.

12." Spire Missouri accepts Staff's recommended rates as reflected in Appendix B-1 and Appendix

B-2 from Staff's recommendation as being the proper raters to be implemented. In short, Spire

Missouri's has filed ISRS rates that are both consistent with Staff's recommended ISRS rates and

that are consistent with the Commission's October 4, 2023 order.

The Commission's Order Approving Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge makes

reference to the Staff's incremental revenue requirement and to the cumulative revenue

requirement², and Spire Missouri's filed rates are consistent with Staff's aforementioned

Appendixes B-1 and B-2 in Staff's recommendation.

In addition, on October 4, 2023, in a separate EFIS submission, Spire Missouri's also filed "Spire

Missouri Inc's Motion For Expedited Treatment". Spire is requesting an effective date for its

submitted tariff of October 16, 2023.

Staff does not object to Spire Missouri's request for expedited treatment to the extent that the

Commission approves a tariff effective date that provides for at least 10 days between

the issue date and the effective date of the Commission order approving the tariff sheet. This is

consistent with the September 28, 2018 Commission "Order Granting Expedited Treatment and

Approving Tariff Filings in Compliance with Commission Order" in Case Nos. GO-2018-0309

and GO-2018-0310.

1. Approves Spire Missouri's ISRS tariff sheet:
