## PROTECTIVE ORDER AND ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

Issue Date: November 8, 2018 Effective Date: November 8, 2018

On October 18, 2018, The Empire District Electric Company (Empire) filed an application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) for two wind projects pursuant to section 393.170, RSMo 2016. Empire also filed a motion for a protective order. The Commission issued a notice and directed any requests for intervention or responses to the motion for protective order be filed no later than November 6, 2018. The notice also directed responses to the intervention requests of the Missouri Energy Consumers Group (MECG) and Renew Missouri Advocates, which were filed prior to the notice being issued.

Empire's motion for a protective order seeks additional protection for certain commercially sensitive information regarding wholesale electric market participants that will be filed, or otherwise disclosed, in this matter. Empire seeks leave to designate that information as "Highly Confidential" as permitted by the Commission's confidential information rule, 4 CSR 240-2.135(4). Empire explained that it was amenable to producing the sensitive information to each party's counsel and outside consultants who execute a Commission nondisclosure agreement on a "Highly Confidential" basis, but not to employees of parties other than the Staff of the Missouri Public Service

Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and the Missouri Department of Economic Development -- Division of Energy. No responses or objections to the motion for protective order were filed and the Commission will grant it.

MECG filed an application to intervene on October 19, 2018, and Renew Missouri Advocates filed a motion to intervene on October 22, 2018. No responses to those requests were filed. The Commission finds that allowing the MECG and Renew Missouri Advocates to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene of MECG and Renew Missouri Advocates.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Renew Missouri Advocates' application to intervene is granted.
- 2. The Missouri Energy Consumers Group's application to intervene is granted.
- 3. Non-public information about wholesale electric markets and non-public information relating to The Empire District Electric Company's Request for Proposal issued as part of its Customer Savings Plan, including responses and related information, shall be designated "Highly Confidential" at the time of its disclosure.
- 4. Disclosure of materials or information designated "Highly Confidential" shall be made only to the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, the Missouri Department of Economic Development -- Division of Energy, counsel of record for each other party, and to outside consultants of each other party who have executed a Commission nondisclosure agreement attached to this order.

- 5. No "Highly Confidential" information shall be provided directly or indirectly to any employee of a party (other than Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and the Missouri Department of Economic Development -- Division of Energy).
- 6. Persons afforded access to materials or information designated "Highly Confidential" shall neither use nor disclose such materials or information for purposes of business or competition or any other purpose other than in regard to this proceeding, and shall keep the materials and information secure and confidential and in accordance with the purposes and intent of this protective order.
- 7. All material and information designated as "Highly Confidential," as well as any notes pertaining to such information, shall be returned to The Empire District Electric Company or destroyed upon the conclusion of this proceeding, with certification of same to Empire.
- 8. If any party disagrees with the "Highly Confidential" designation of any information, that party shall follow the informal discovery dispute resolution procedures set forth in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090(8). If these dispute resolution procedures are exhausted without resolution, the party may file a motion challenging the designation.
  - 9. This order shall be effective when issued.
