Issue Date: November 14, 2018 Effective Date: November 14, 2018 On October 18, 2018, The Empire District Electric Company (Empire) filed an application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) for two wind projects pursuant to section 393.170, RSMo 2016. The Commission issued a notice and directed any requests for intervention be filed no later than November 6, 2018.

Timely requests to intervene were received from the Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC), the Sierra Club, and the Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC). More than ten days have passed since those applications to intervene were filed and no one has responded to the applications.

The Commission finds that allowing the NRDC, Sierra Club, and MDC to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Natural Resources Defense Council's application to intervene is granted.

2. The Sierra Club's application to intervene is granted.

3. The Missouri Department of Conservation's application to intervene is granted.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
