



of the filing of Raytown's request for a rate increase.<sup>2</sup> Counting the two week extension the Parties agreed to, the Commission calculates that day 270 is January 13, 2024. The ordered procedural schedule set reply briefs due December 13.<sup>3</sup> Because of the timeframe involved in submitting the case to the Commission, the Commission finds good cause to waive the 270-day deadline.<sup>4</sup>

Nevertheless, the Commission shall make all reasonable efforts to issue an order to be effective as soon as practicable after the submission of the case for decision.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The proposed tariff sheets assigned Tracking No. JW-2024-0039 are suspended until January 29, 2024, or until further ordered by the Commission.
2. The 270-day deadline for a Commission decision to become effective is waived for good cause, pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-10.075(15).
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
