NOTICE THAT TARIFFS WILL BE ALLOWED TO GO INTO EFFECT

Issue Date: October 10, 2018

On August 27, 2018, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) filed a joint application requesting that the Commission grant it variances from 4 CSR 240-20.065, to allow them to remove the “solar rebate application” information from their respective Net Metering Tariffs.

KCP&L and GMO subsequently filed those tariffs on August 27, 2018, with an October 15, 2018 effective date. On September 24, 2018, the Commission’s Staff filed a recommendation and memorandum recommending approval of the variance and the tariffs. Staff’s memorandum explains that the tariff changes proposed by KCP&L and GMO recognize the size differences of the Net Metering and Easy Connection Act in Section 386.890 RSMo, at 100 kW, versus the size limitation for solar rebates to non-residential customers under Section 393.1670 RSMo, at 150 kW. Staff also notes potential efficiencies to be gained in administering the programs via separating the solar

rebate application from the net metering application. The Commission received no filings opposing the requested variance. Staff advises the Commission to approve the tariff sheets to go into effect on their October 15, 2018, effective date.

The Commission hereby gives notice that KCP&L and GMO's tariffs will go into effect by operation of law on the proposed October 15, 2018 effective date.
