STAFF'S RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S AND KCP&L GREATER MISSOURI OPERATIONS COMPANY'S REQUESTED VARIANCES

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri and states to the Commission that it recommends the tariff sheets filed by Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations ("KCPL and GMO") on August 27, 2018 be approved to become effective October 15, 2018.

- On August 27, 2018, KCPL and GMO filed their Joint Application for a variance from selected provisions of 4 CSR 240-20.065 ("Request for Variances").
 On August 28, 2018, the Commission ordered Staff to file its Recommendation no later than September 24, 2018.
- 2. Staff has reviewed KCPL and GMO's Joint Application and as a result of its review states that it supports the variance request. Details of the variance requests are discussed in Staff's Memorandum.

WHEREFORE, for reasons stated above and in Staff's Memorandum, Staff recommends to the Commission that it:

OVERVIEW

Staff has reviewed the Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") and KCPL Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") (collectively "Applicants") Joint Application for a Variance from the Provisions of 4 CSR 240-20.065 Regarding Net Metering and associated tariff sheets filed on August 27, 2018. As a result of passage of Section 393.1670 RSMo, KCP&L and GMO have requested to remove the solar rebate application sections from the "Interconnection Application/Agreement for Net Metering Systems with Capacity of 100 kW or Less." The solar rebate tariff sheets related to Section 393.1670 RSMo. were also filed in JE-2019-0027 and JE-2019-0028.

DISCUSSION

Variance:

The Applicants request a variance from 4 CSR 240-20.065 to remove the solar rebate application (Section H and I of the Interconnection Application/ Agreement for Net Metering Systems with Capacity of 100 kW or Less) from the net-metering application. Staff supports the variance request for the following reasons:

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• Customers receiving a solar rebate under Section 393.1670 may interconnect under the

Net Metering tariff or the Company's Qualifying Facility tariff. This is related to the size

limitation for offering solar rebates to non-residential customers under Section 393.1670

RSMo (150 kW) in comparison to the size limitation of the Net Metering and Easy

Connection Act in Section 386.890 RSMo (100 kW).

• There are potential efficiencies to be gained, in terms of the Applicants' administration of

the programs, from separating the solar rebate application from the net metering

application.

Net Metering Interconnection Application Agreement:

The primary revision to the Net Metering Interconnection Application Agreement is to separate

the Solar Rebate application from the Net Metering application; as discussed above, Staff is

supportive of the revision to improve the administration of these programs. Other revisions to the

Net Metering Interconnection Application Agreement include clarifying that kilowatt sizing is in

reference to DC rather than AC, requiring grid support inverters, and allowing customers to

apply via an online portal.

Staff has reviewed the Company's online application portal. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-

20.065(9)(A)1A. requires the interconnection application on the utility's website to be

substantially the same as the interconnection form included in the rule. Staff will note that the net

metering tariff (including application) is linked to the online portal such that the customer can

easily review the effective tariff. The fields on the online portal are generally the same as the rule

form, though some items were not included such as additional contact fields (mailing, service

address, emergency contact).

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Solar Rebate Tariff:

The proposed changes to the solar rebate tariffs incorporates tariff sheets1 allowing for the

Applicants to accept solar rebate applications related to Senate Bill 564 (Section 393.1670

RSMo). The Applicants have completed payments of solar rebates under Section 393.1030;

therefore, the proposed tariff sheets replace the previous solar rebate program.

KCP&L's tariff titled "Solar Photovoltaic Rebate Program - Schedule SR 393.1670 RSMo

(2019-2023)" and GMO's tariff titled "Rules and Regulations Electric 9.18 Solar Photovoltaic

Rebate Program" include an open pool of funding up to \$8 million per company rather than a

yearly cap.

Additionally, each company has reserved \$500,000 for customers who qualify under the

Business Social Service Program. The Business Social Service Program is for non-profit

businesses that receive general electric service and are primarily used for low-income public

social services2. Any funds reserved for the Business Social Service Program will be made

available to all customers after June 30, 2020.

The availability requirements of the new tariff are similar to the previously offered solar rebates

(Section 393.1030), except that there is a requirement that customers install a grid support

inverter.

Tariff:

Staff recommends that the Commission approve the following tariff sheets, as filed on

August 27, 2018, to go into effect for service on and after October 15, 2018, the requested

effective date:

1 PSC MO. No. 7 Sheets 46 through 46E for Kansas City Power and Light Company; PSC MO. No. 1 Sheets R-62.19 through R-62.25 for KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations.

2 Such as food banks, food pantries, soup kitchens, homeless shelters, employment services, worker training, job banks, and child care or otherwise determined by the Company.
