NOTICE OF SATISFACTION OF COMPLAINT

COMES NOW United Cities Gas Company, a division of Atmos Energy Corporation, ("United Cities"), and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.070, respectfully notifies the Commission that the Complaint filed by the Palmyra R-1 School District on January 12, 2001, has been satisfied. In support of this Notice, United Cities states as follows:

- 1. On January 12, 2001, Palmyra R-1 School District filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against United Cities alleging that the Company is attempting to recover from Complainant approximately Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) in undercharges that resulted from a billing error made by United Cities.
- 2. After careful consideration, United Cities has decided not to bill the Complainant and other commercial customers in Palmyra for a billing error that occurred during the 1998-99 and 1999-2000 heating season when the Company inadvertently billed the Complainant and other commercial customers its summer rates rather than its higher winter rates. United Cities has notified the Complainant of its decision not to seek recovery of these undercharges, and Complainant has indicated that the Company's decision fully resolves its Complaint.

WHEREFORE, United Cities Gas Company, a division of Atmos Energy Company, respectfully notifies the Commission that it has satisfied the Complaint filed in this proceeding, and therefore requests that the Complaint be dismissed and the case closed.
