NOTICE THAT TARIFF WILL BE ALLOWED TO GO INTO EFFECT

Issue Date: December 5, 2018

On August 21, 2018, Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC") filed P.S.C. Mo. No. 13, 2nd Revised Tariff Sheet No. R. 65 to replace the 1st Revised Tariff Sheet No. R. 65. The tariff had an effective date of September 20, 2018. The tariff sheet changes how MAWC accounts for income taxes that accrue from Contributions in Aid of Construction ("CIAC"). The tariff proposes:

Any Federal, State or Local income tax incurred by the Company due to the receipt of taxable Advances or Contributions in Aid of Construction, as defined by the Internal Revenue Service, the State of Missouri, or other taxing authority, and not otherwise paid by a third party, will be paid by the Company. Such income taxes shall be segregated in a deferred account for inclusion in rate base in the Company's next general rate proceeding.

On August 24, 2018, the Commission's Staff ("Staff") filed a motion to suspend the tariff and conduct proceedings to determine whether to adopt or reject the proposed tariff. The Commission suspended the tariff until December 7. On October 29, the Commission granted intervention to the Homebuilders Association of St. Louis and Eastern Missouri and Avondale Custom Homes, LLC. Staff filed a recommendation on

November 5, arguing the deferral of CIAC income tax impacts, as contemplated in the tariff, should only be authorized to continue until such time as new rates go into effect from MAWC's next general rate case proceeding. At a procedural conference held November 21, the intervening parties indicated they were not opposed to the tariffs being effective until MAWC's next general rate proceeding. Staff indicated it would not be requesting further suspension of the tariff.

Given Staff's recommendation and no opposition to the tariff taking effect, the Commission will allow MAWC's tariff to take effect by operation of law on December 7, 2018.
