NOTICE CLOSING FILE

Issue Date: October 18, 2023

Complainant, Brett Felber, filed a complaint against Respondent, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, on October 11, 2023. Complainant alleges that in his previous complaint before the Commission, File No. EC-2023-0395¹, Ameren Missouri's witness admitted to altering her personal emails. Ameren Missouri's witness stated that she did that for the purpose of investigating the ease with which Complainant could alter the date on his emails. Complainant also claims that legal counsel for Ameren Missouri committed perjury in documents filed in File No. EC-2023-0395. Complainant enumerated these grievances in motions filed after the hearing in File No. EC-2023-0395.

In an additional filing on October 12, 2023, Complainant alleges that verbiage on Ameren Missouri's payment agreements presented to its customers is intentionally misleading and should be modified. He further alleges that Ameren Missouri's

communications regarding the billing dispute process is misleading. These allegations are also being addressed in File No. EC-2023-0395.

Complainant requests the Commission investigate Ameren Missouri's conduct and statements made in the evidentiary hearing in File No. EC-2023-0395.

Complainant's new complaint against Ameren Missouri alleges "no violation of any law subject to the commission's authority, of any rule promulgated by the commission, of any utility tariff, or of any order or decision of the commission"² that is not already being addressed in File No. EC-2023-0395. Those matters are most appropriately addressed within the bounds of that complaint. The Commission will treat this new complaint as late filed objections to testimony and evidence in File No. EC-2023-0395.

The Commission makes determinations on evidentiary rulings, including the credibility of witness testimony or documents, the appropriate weight given to evidence, and objections. The Commission will make those determinations in File No. EC-2023-0395. Accordingly, this file will be closed.
