RESPONSE OF KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY TO STAFF MEMORANDUM AND RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") to file its response to Staff Memorandum and Recommendation dated November 20, 2003:

- KCPL concurs with the approval of KCPL's proposed unexecuted amendment to
 its existing Amended and Restated Trust Agreement ("Agreement") and KCPL
 will file with the Commission an executed copy of the amended Agreement.
- KCPL would request that the Staff's five subsequent conditions not be included as
 part of the Commission's Order because KCPL believes these issues can be
 addressed without such action.
- 3. KCPL has in the past and will continue in the future to timely and completely file applications to amend its Agreement although circumstances and requirements may differ with future filings. KCPL agrees to obtain prior approvals of amendments to the Agreement when possible, provide notice to Staff within a reasonable time after notice of any new provision requiring amendment of the Agreement, and include the proposed changes to the Agreement in the application.

WHEREFORE, Kansas City Power & Light Company respectfully requests that the Commission consider its response, and thanks the Commission for the opportunity to present its views. KCPL requests that the Commission issue an Order approving a change in the nuclear decommissioning trust agreement to conform with the NRC rules without requiring the Staff's other recommendations for future KCPL Agreement applications.
