### ORDER AND NOTICE

The Deaf Relay Service and Equipment Distribution Program Fund (Relay Missouri Fund) is a statewide dual-party telephone relay service for qualifying Missourians who are unable to use traditional telecommunications equipment due to disability. That service is funded by a surcharge on Missouri landline basic access lines. On December 11, 2018, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion requesting that the Commission maintain the Relay Missouri Surcharge at four cents (\$.04) per month, and maintain the existing retention amount at one percent of the total Fund surcharge collected or \$30 per month, whichever is greater. The Commission will give interested parties an opportunity to intervene and to respond to Staff's motion.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:
