## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On November 18, 2018, The Empire District Electric Company (Empire) filed an application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) for a wind project pursuant to section 393.170, RSMo 2016. The Commission issued a notice and directed any requests for intervention be filed no later than December 10, 2018.

A timely request to intervene was received from the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy. More than ten days have passed since that application to intervene was filed and no one has responded to the application.

The Commission finds that allowing the Division of Energy to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy application to intervene is granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
