On October 2, 2012, the Commission's Staff filed a notice informing the Commission that Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) had not yet filed revised tariffs to incorporate recent changes to the Commission's net metering rules, nor had they sought a waiver regarding that requirement of the rule. Staff's notice sought direction from the Commission as to whether it should file a complaint against those companies. On October 3, KCPL and GMO filed a motion in File No. EE-2013-0125 asking for a variance from the Commission's rules to allow them until December 1, 2012, to file the required revisions to their net metering tariffs.

The Commission will direct its Staff to file a pleading indicating whether KCPL and GMO's filing satisfies Staff's concerns and whether Staff needs any further direction from the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Staff shall file a pleading no later than October 24, 2012, indicating whether Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's October 3 filing satisfies Staff's concerns and whether Staff needs any further direction from the Commission.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
