PUBLIC COUNSEL REPLY

COMES NOW the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) and for its Reply states as follows:

- 1. On March 19, 2001 UtiliCorp United Inc. (Company) filed its Suggestions of UtiliCorp United, Inc. in Opposition to Office of the Public Counsel's Motion to Dismiss or Suspend. Also on March 19, 2001, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its Response and Motion to Consolidate.
- 2. Public Counsel supports Staff's motion to consolidate Cases No. ET-2001-482, GT-2001-484, and HT-2001-485. Staff is correct that these three cases should be consolidated because the issues in all three cases are virtually identical and a uniform result is desirable. Consolidation will greatly promote administrative efficiency and reduce the waste of duplicative filings.
- 3. Public Counsel is confused regarding Company's assertions in Paragraph 4 and 6 of its March 19, 2001 Suggestions. Company's claims that the Commission has approved the

tariffs in question. Public Counsel has not been served with a copy of the cover letter dated March 6, 2001 that was referenced in Company's Paragraph 4.

In Paragraph 6, Company asserts but does not explain how Public Counsel's motion could be prohibited by 4 CSR 240-2.065. The proposed effective date for the tariffs in question is still May 1, 2001, and Public Counsel believes that it has now fully complied with 4 CSR 240-2.065 in its request that the Commission suspend these tariffs and allow Public Counsel to provide testimony and suggestions in support of its arguments that the tariffs would constitute (1) unlawful single issue ratemaking, and (2) a detriment to Company's customers contrary to the Commission's decision in the merger case, Case No. EM-2000-292.

WHEREFORE, Public Counsel respectfully requests that the Commission consolidate cases numbered ET-2001-482, GT-2001-484 and HT-2001-485 and schedule an early prehearing conference as requested by Staff.
