## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On April 15, 2013, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) its Annual Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100. On May 7, 2013, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers filed an application to intervene. On May 10, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources filed an application to intervene. The Commission set a deadline for any party wishing to respond to the applications to intervene, but no parties have objected to the applications. The applications satisfy all requirements of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075 and intervention will be granted.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The application to intervene filed by the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers is granted.
2. The application to intervene filed by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources is granted.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
