#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation states:

- 1. On March 31, 2001, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE), filed an Application pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060(4) with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission).
- 2. The Application requests that the Commission grant MGE a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CCN) authorizing it to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain a natural gas transmission and distribution system for the public in an area in Newton County near Neosho, Missouri.
- 3. In the attached Memorandum, labeled Appendix A, the Staff explains its reasons for recommending that the Commission grant the Application.
  - 4. There were no intervenors in the case.

WHEREFORE Staff recommends that the Commission approve the Application as in the public interest and order MGE to file a revision to its tariff sheet to reflect this change in its existing certificated area.

On March 23, 2001, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE), a Division of Southern Union Company filed a Application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (Application) to serve an additional portion of Newton County near Neosho, Missouri. The service area is more specifically described as Section 10 of Township 25 North, Range 32 West in Newton County which is approximately one square mile in area. On April 10, 2001, the Commission ordered that a proper party wishing to intervene in this matter do so by April 24, 2001. No parties intervened in this case.

After MGE filed the Application, the customer that MGE intended to serve in its original filing chose an alternative energy source. However, MGE expects future development in this area and the possibility that the customer could, at a later date, choose to be served by MGE.

Staff has reviewed the Application and is of the opinion that the filing complies with Commission rules. After reviewing the Application as well as additional information provided by MGE, Staff maintains that this Application is in the public interest. Therefore, Staff recommends approval of the Application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to serve an additional portion of Newton County near Neosho, Missouri. Staff also recommends that the Commission order MGE to file a revision to tariff sheet No. 6.14 to reflect the addition of Section 10 of Township 25 North, Range 32 West in Newton County.
