STATEMENT OF THE STAFF CONCERNING THE

HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL DESIGNATION OF PORTIONS OF STAFF'S TESTIMONY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Commission (Staff) and, concerning the information that was designated as Highly Confidential (HC) in its Rebuttal testimony, states as follows:

- 1. The Staff has prepared and filed the Rebuttal testimony of six witnesses in this case. Much of the testimony has significant portions that have been designated as HC.
- 2. The Joint Applicants requested a Protective Order and stated to the Commission that disclosure of certain information would be harmful to them and to their customers. The Commission issued its Order Granting Protective Order on May 2, 2001.
- 3. In its rebuttal testimony, Staff has taken a conservative approach to the designation of testimony as Highly Confidential, and, in some cases, has designated large portions of testimony as HC because the preponderance of information received from Applicant Gateway Pipeline Company was designated as HC.
- 4. For example, most of the information contained in Ms. Morrissey's testimony is publicly available elsewhere and Staff believes that to make all of Ms. Morrissey's testimony public would not result in any harm to Gateway.

- 5. Staff is not the "party asserting the claim" that information should be considered HC. The interest in protecting the information, and thus the burden of maintaining the HC designation, is on the proponents of such designation. Staff, therefore, requests that the Joint Applicants review Staff's testimony to determine whether some, if not most, of the testimony may be considered public.
- 6. If the Joint Applicants determine that any of the information that Staff has designated as HC may be considered to be public information, Staff will refile its Non-Proprietary testimony to include any information that Joint Applicants indicate may be reclassified as public.

WHEREFORE the Staff advises the Commission that it believes that some or all of the materials designated as HC in Staff's Rebuttal testimony may be declassified as public and urges Gateway to designate which portions may be made public.
