TO RESPOND TO MOTION TO PRESENT LIVE TESTIMONY**

On April 21, 2014, the Natural Resources Defense Council, Earth Island Institute, d/b/a Renew Missouri, and Sierra Club filed a motion asking leave to present the live testimony of their expert witness, Phillip Mosenthal, at the upcoming evidentiary hearing. The movants explain that Mosenthal did not prefile testimony, but that his live testimony is necessary to explain why the movants support the stipulation and agreement that has been filed in this case.

Before ruling on the motion, the Commission will establish a time for other parties to respond.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any party wishing to respond to the Motion for Present Live Testimony shall do so no later than 1:00 p.m. on April 24, 2014.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
