STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO APPROVE TARIFF SHEETS

COMES NOW Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through the undersigned counsel, and hereby submits Staff's recommendation for the Commission to approve the tariff sheets issued by Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") on June 6, 2014,¹ with an effective date of July 6, and assigned Tariff Tracking Nos. YE-2014-0532 and YE-2014-0533. In support hereof, Staff states as follows:

1. On May 27, KCP&L, along with other parties to this case, filed a Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement Resolving Kansas City Power & Light Company's MEEIA Filing ("Stipulation and Agreement"). The Stipulation and Agreement requested the Commission's approval of 12 demand-side programs pursuant to the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act ("MEEIA"). The Stipulation and Agreement also requested the Commission authorize KCP&L to establish a demand-side programs investment mechanism ("DSIM") to recover MEEIA Programs' costs, KCP&L's Throughput Disincentive Net Shared Benefits ("TD-NSB") Share that is intended to recover estimated lost margin revenues, and any earned Performance Incentive Award.

Staff and KCP&L also agreed in the *Stipulation and Agreement* to support the use of a rider for MEEIA purposes only.

- 2. On June 5, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement* and ordered that KCP&L may file new tariff sheets consistent with the approved *Stipulation and Agreement*.
- 3. On June 6, KCP&L issued tariff sheets for its Commission approved MEEIA programs and approved DSIM with the effective date of July 6. After discussion with Staff, KCP&L filed a substitute tariff sheet for Sheet No. TOC-1 on June 26.
- 4. Although not specifically ordered to do so, Staff files this recommendation, and the attached *Memorandum* prepared by Ms. Tammy Huber, Utility Policy Analyst II within the Energy Resource Analysis Unit of the Commission. It is Staff's opinion that the tariff sheets listed in Staff's *Memorandum* are in compliance with the Commission's *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement*.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends the Commission issue an Order approving the compliance tariff sheets as listed in Staff's *Memorandum* and assigned Tracking Nos. YE-2014-0532 and YE-2014-0533, to become effective on July 6, 2014.

Summary

On May 27, 2014, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") along with other parties to Case No. EO-2014-0095, Kansas City Power & Light Company's Filing for Approval of Demand-Side Programs and for Authority to Establish a Demand Side Programs Investment Mechanism, filed a *Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement Resolving Kansas City Power & Light Company's MEEIA Filing* ("Stipulation and Agreement"). The Stipulation and Agreement resolved all issues in the case amongst the signatories and requested the Commission's approval of 12 demand-side programs pursuant to the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act ("MEEIA"). The Stipulation and Agreement also requested the Commission authorize KCP&L to establish a demand-side programs investment mechanism ("DSIM") to recover MEEIA Programs' costs, KCP&L's Throughput Disincentive Net Shared Benefits ("TD-NSB") Share that is intended to recover lost margin revenues, and any earned Performance Incentive Award. Staff and KCP&L agreed to support the use of a rider for MEEIA purposes only. On June 5, 2014, the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued its *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement*.

On June 6, 2014, KCP&L filed tariff sheets for its approved demand-side programs and approved DSIM to comply with the *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement*. The filed tariff sheets were assigned Tariff Tracking Nos. YE-2014-0532 and YE-2014-0533, and all filed tariff sheets have an issue date of June 6, 2014 and an effective date of July 6, 2014. At Staff's

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request, KCP&L filed a substitute tariff sheet on June 26, 2014, to correct information on the Table of Contents, Thirteenth Revised Sheet NO. TOC-1, Cancelling Twelfth Revised Sheet No. TOC-1.

In response to paragraph 6 of the *Stipulation and Agreement* the Company will begin recovery through a DSIM Rider in the August 2014 billing or as soon as practical thereafter.

Thirteenth Revised Sheet No. TOC-1

The Thirteenth Revised Sheet No. TOC-1, Canceling Twelfth Revised Sheet No. TOC-1, as submitted on June 6, 2014, omitted several sheet numbers with the schedule title of "Reserved for Future Use". On June 26, 2014 Staff advised KCP&L personnel to file a substitute tariff sheet to include all sheet numbers including the DSIM sheet number on the table of contents tariff sheet. KCP&L submitted its substitute tariff sheet P.S.C. MO. No. 7 Thirteenth Revised Sheet No. TOC-1, Cancelling Twelfth Revised Sheet No. TOC-1 June 26, 2014.

Staff Recommendation

MPSC Staff reviewed the tariff sheets KCP&L filed on June 6, 2014, and as substituted on June 26, 2014, and has determined that KCP&L tariff sheets comply with the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement in Case No. EO-2014-0095. Accordingly, staff recommends that the Commission approve the following tariff sheets, so that each tariff sheet becomes effective July 6, 2014.
