NOTICE OF CASE FILING

COMES NOW Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI) and, under 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1), hereby files notice that it intends to file an application for a certificate under Section 393.170.1 for transmission investments in Northeast Missouri, as follows:

1. Section 393.170.1, RSMo. requires electrical corporations subject to the Commission’s jurisdiction to obtain a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CCN) prior to construction of transmission facilities unless those facilities are located within the corporation’s certificated service territory. ATXI has no certificated service territory.

2. There are transmission infrastructure needs in Northeast Missouri that will be satisfied by the project that will be the subject of this filing.

3. Specifically, ATXI is proposing to construct a new transmission switching station to serve as the point-of-interconnection with a renewable generation facility being developed by an unaffiliated entity.

4. The issues likely to be before the Commission respecting the CCN application include whether the requested CCN is necessary or convenient for the public service, including an examination of the “Tartan” factors.

5. ATXI has had no communications with the Office of the Commission (as defined in

20CSR 4240-4.015(10) respecting this matter during the preceding 90 days.
