ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S MOTION FOR TEST YEAR AND TRUE-UP CUTOFF DATE

Effective Date: February 19, 2019

On January 29, 2019, the Commission's Staff requested that the Test Year for this rate case be the 12 months ending June 30, 2018. Additionally, Staff requests a True-Up period cutoff date of May 31, 2019. Staff also requested constraints regarding anticipated True-Up items.

On February 8, 2019, Ameren Missouri filed a response to Staff's motion agreeing to the Test Year and True-Up cutoff date requested by Staff. Ameren Missouri does not oppose Staff's requested constraints regarding anticipated True-Up items. No other party has filed a pleading with regard to the Test Year and True-Up period.

The Commission will set these periods as requested by Staff and Ameren Missouri.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission's motion is granted.
2. The Test Year shall be the 12 months ending June 30, 2018.
3. The True-Up period cutoff date shall be May 31, 2019.
4. Anticipated True-Up items shall be addressed as put forth in Staff's *Motion*

to Establish Test Year and True-Up Cutoff Date.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
