ORDER GRANTING CLARIFICATION OF ORDER REGARDING CLASSIFICATION OF RESPONSES TO DATA REQUESTS

Summary:

On August 28, 2001, the Commission issued its Order Regarding Classification of Responses to Data Requests. On August 30, 2001, Gateway Pipeline Company, Inc., filed a Request for Clarification, or in the Alternative, Application for Rehearing and Motion for Reconsideration. This order provides the clarification requested by Gateway.

Clarification:

The Commission's August 28, 2001, order classified the response to data request No. 2002 as proprietary. Data request No. R012 contained information from the response to data request No. 2002. When the Commission addressed data request No. R012 in its order, the Commission deleted proprietary information from its recital of the request itself.

Gateway requested that the Commission clarify that proprietary information contained in a data request retains its proprietary status and should not be published or



revealed including instances where it may be necessary to restate the information in a subsequent data request.

The Commission finds that proprietary information obtained in response to a data request should retain its classification and the protected status of the information should be preserved including instances where it may be necessary to restate the information in a subsequent data request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the motion of Gateway Pipeline Company, Inc., filed on August 30,
 2001, requesting clarification is granted in part and denied in part.
- 2. That proprietary information in the response to data request No. 2002 will be preserved as confidential on the basis of its proprietary status and any proprietary information presented in data request No. RO12 shall remain proprietary.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on October 8, 2001.


