the fact that the usual procedure would be for Schreiber Foods to be receiving each month a supply of natural gas from TXUES via Williams Pipeline.

7. For August of 2000, per its usual procedure, TXUES nominated a volume of natural gas for the Schreiber Foods' facility with Williams Pipeline company. However, for an as of yet unknown reason, Williams Pipeline has no record of such nomination and consequently did not notify MGE of same.
8. MGE noted that no gas had been nominated for, or scheduled for delivery at, the Schreiber Foods' Mt. Vernon facility for August 2000, but failed to properly notify either the individual authorized for energy matters at Schreiber Foods or TXUES of this situation or to make the potential financial consequences of this lack of nomination known to anyone at Schreiber Foods.

As a result, Schreiber Foods received a penalty bill for August in the amount of \$78,000, which, in essence, became the first and only formal notification to responsible personnel at Schreiber Foods that the normal nomination procedure had not taken place and the first notification of any sort that the lack of nomination would result in penalty charges. This billing was not sent to the attention of a person responsible for energy matters at Schreiber Foods or, indeed, to the attention of anyone or any department, but was mailed to the Schreiber Foods plant in Mt. Vernon.
