On February 8, 2019, Falcon Cablevision, a California Limited Partnership d/b/a Charter Communications, pursuant to §67.2701, RSMo 2016, filed a *Notice of Change Application* indicating the assignment of their video service authorization to Spectrum Mid-America, LLC.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Spectrum Mid-America, LLC is granted authority to provide video service in the franchise area of each political subdivision set forth in the application and restated above; and

2. Spectrum Mid-America, LLC is granted authority to construct a video service network along, across, or on public rights-of-way for the delivery of video service to the extent the video service provider or an affiliate did not otherwise possess a valid authorization to occupy the public rights-of-way.

3. At their own request, all authority granted to Falcon Cablevision, a California Limited Partnership d/b/a Charter Communications to provide video service is hereby cancelled.

4. This order shall become effective when issued, after which this case may be closed.

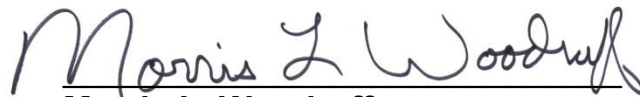
