ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On September 15, 2021, the Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty filed tariff sheets and an application seeking the Commission’s approval to establish a Demand Side Investment Mechanism under the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA). The Commission issued an order directing notice, and setting a deadline of October 22, 2021, for requests to intervene.

On October 8, 2021, the Missouri Division of Energy, the National Housing Trust, and Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri filed applications to intervene. Ten days have elapsed, and no party has objected to the applications to intervene.¹ The applications satisfy the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075 and intervention will be granted.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The applications to intervene filed by the Missouri Division of Energy, the National Housing Trust, and Renew Missouri are granted.

¹ Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(13) provides that parties shall be allowed ten days from the date of filing in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. This order is effective when issued.
