ORDER DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION OR JOINT PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On February 14, 2023, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty filed an application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) authorizing Liberty to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage two combustion turbine generators, each with a nominal net output of 13.3 MW to replace existing combustion turbine generators Riverton Unit 10 and Riverton Unit 11.

On May 9, 2023, Liberty filed a *Motion for Stay of Proceedings* to allow Liberty time to address additional developments regarding the generation interconnection process with the Southwest Power Pool and to provide additional information to the Staff of the Commission (Staff) and other parties regarding the details of the proposed project. On May 10, 2023, the Commission granted Liberty's motion and stayed the proceedings in this matter.

On October 13, 2023, Liberty filed an *Amended Application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity*. The Commission will direct Staff to file a recommendation on the amended application or, if appropriate, a joint proposed procedural schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than December 15, 2023, Staff shall file a recommendation on Liberty's *Amended Application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity*. However, in lieu of a recommendation, if the parties deem an evidentiary hearing appropriate, Staff shall collaborate with the other parties and file–also no later than December 15, 2023–a joint proposed procedural schedule on behalf of all parties.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
