The accompanying tariff sheets issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company), are being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 6, Schedule of Rates for Electricity:

These tariff sheets are being issued January 27, 2014 to become effective on and after February 26, 2014.

The Company is filing the Solar Rebate tariff in order to conform to suggestions made by Staff in Staff's Response to Order Directing Staff to Respond to Ameren Missouri's Application For Rehearing in File No. ET-2014-0085. However, Company has substituted the phrase "Rebate Commitment" for Staff's suggested language of "customer's receipt of rebate offer" since "Rebate Commitment" is a defined term in the tariff, is more precise and doesn't rely on knowledge of the customer's "receipt".

The Company is also filing the net metering tariff so that a net metering design approval can be reissued in order to align the expiration dates for the net metering approval and the solar rebate commitment.

Both of these changes have been discussed with and accepted by Staff.

Finally, Company is requesting that the tariffs be granted expedited treatment as set forth in the pleading filed concurrent with the tariff.
