On December 17, 2015, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its LED Lighting Update Report in compliance with the *Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement Regarding MEEIA Low Income Exemption and LED Streetlighting Issues*, which was submitted in File No. ER-2014-0258 and approved by the Commission on March 21, 2015. On December 17, 2015, the Commission issued an order directing notice of the report and tariff and setting a deadline of December 24, 2015 for persons requesting to intervene in this matter. The City of O'Fallon and the Missouri Department of Economic Development-Division of Energy filed timely applications to intervene. No party has objected to the applications. The applications satisfy all requirements of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075 and intervention will be granted.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application to intervene filed by the City of O'Fallon is granted.
2. The application to intervene filed by the Missouri Department of Economic Development-Division of Energy is granted.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
