On December 17, 2015, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its LED Lighting Update Report in compliance with the *Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement Regarding MEEIA Low Income Exemption and LED Streetlighting Issues*, which was submitted in File No. ER-2014-0258 and approved by the Commission on March 21, 2015.
