- 1. On October 31, 2018 the Commission approved a *Stipulation and Agreement* in this case which recommended approval of a tariff sheet modifying The Empire District Electric Company's (Liberty) economic development rider (EDR) approved in a prior rate case (File No. ER-2012-0345).
