### Response To Commission

To whom this may concern, I understand that Evergy is based out of Kansas City, Missouri and Kansas City, Kansas.

What I am asking is that they are allowed to come into the territory and intercept the transformers, utility padmounts, service lines, to utilize their service and Evergy can charge and bill me for services. Their meters already utilize the same capabilities as what Ameren's meters do and use the same transmission features.

Pretty much it would be like a MVNO of the cellular industry only in utility services, instead.

Ameren is NOT the owner of the transmission lines, utility lines, padmounts, meters or transformers. Those are owned by a different company, however Ameren is allowed to utilize the lines and perform service and upgrades to those grids. To power customers.

Technically, Evergy would be able to utilize those as Ameren isn't the beneficial owner or the owner of each of the items above.

The reason for their change is it is obvious that Ameren is going to continue to extort me into trying to have me pay a balance I don't owe. I shouldn't be forced into paying something I don't owe, nor do I owe, should I be forced to pay something because they violated numerous commission rules, regulations and tariffs.

I as a customer, shouldn't be forced or extorted to pay a bill I don't agree with and a company takes lack of responsibility of sending the corresponding information to verify or validate the debt.

I have a copy of the police report filed along with a FTC letter showing I don't owe the debt Ameren claims.

Essentially, Ameren wants money, they don't have the authority to collect, nor send to a collection agency to properly give me services that should be working.

By allowing Evergy to come in and intercept the line, utilize it as their own and bill me for services tag the meter and line would ensure that I as a person get working services, with transparency.

What Ameren Missouri is being allowed to do is highway robbery and illegal.

Nobody as a person should be forced to pay a bill they don't owe and make the position to pay a bill they don't owe or not have proper working utility services.

However, as Ameren Missouri doesn't actually own any of the grids, transformers, padmounts, etc, they do not have the right to not release it to another utility provider to enter the area.

If needed, I'm willing to supply a utility & financial bond from financial company to ensure Evergy can utilize this.
