**ORDER REGARDING APPLICATION FOR
REHEARING AND MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION**

On December 21, 2018, Wisper ISP Inc. filed an application with the Commission seeking designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier in the state of Missouri. On February 14, 2019, the Commission issued an order granting Wisper ISP Inc. designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier with an effective date of February 24, 2019.

On February 22, 2019, intervening parties Conexon, LLC and GoSEMO, LLC jointly filed an application for rehearing and motion for reconsideration regarding the Commission's Order Granting Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier to Wisper ISP Inc. and various procedural orders contained therein.

The Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear."¹ Further, "(m)otions for reconsideration of procedural and interlocutory orders shall set forth specifically the ground(s) on which the applicant

considers the order to be unlawful, unjust, or unreasonable.”² The Commission finds that Conexon, LLC, and GoSEMO, LLC failed to establish a sufficient reason for rehearing and for reconsideration. Therefore, the Commission will deny the application and motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Joint Application for Rehearing and Motion for Reconsideration filed by Conexon, LLC and GoSEMO, LLC is denied.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.


