PROTECTIVE ORDER

Invenergy Transmission LLC, on behalf of itself and its parent company Invenergy Investment Company, LLC (collectively Invenergy) and Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC, on behalf of itself and its parent company Grain Belt Express Holding LLC (collectively Grain Belt) filed a Motion for Protective Order on March 15, 2019. Invenergy and Grain Belt asked the Commission to issue a protective order to allow them to designate certain highly sensitive commercial information relating to financial statements and interconnection queue issues as highly confidential, thereby limiting the dissemination of that information. In particular, they ask the Commission to issue an order that provides the same level of protection for the information as was established in File No. EA-2016-0358, which concerns Grain Belt's application for a certificate of convenience and necessity.

The motion represented that certain parties, although not all the parties, were consulted about this request and did not object. The Commission ordered that any party wishing to respond to the motion do so by March 19. The only response was filed by Joseph and Rose Kroner, the Missouri Landowners Alliance, and Show-Me Concerned Landowners, and confirmed that they do not oppose the requested protective order.

The protective order requested by Invenergy and Grain Belt is a reasonable means of protecting commercially sensitive information and is not opposed by any party. The Commission will issue the requested protective order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Invenergy and Grain Belt's Motion for Protective Order is granted. Competitively sensitive information designated by Invenergy or Grain Belt as highly confidential shall be disclosed only to attorneys of record for all parties, to state agency parties and their employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, and to designated outside experts of any non-state agency party.
- 2. All outside experts must complete the certification process described in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.135(7). Except for attorneys of record for all parties, and employees of state agency employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, all persons authorized to access "highly confidential" information in this case shall complete the nondisclosure agreement attached to this order as Exhibit A.
 - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
