On March 14, 2008, Great Plains Energy Incorporated, Kansas City Power & Light Company, and Aquila, Inc. (collectively referred to as “the Joint Applicants”), filed a reply to the motion of the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and Praxair, Inc., AG Processing, Inc., and Sedalia Industrial Energy Users’ Association. That motion had requested the Commission to issue an order directing compliance with the Commission’s June 19, 2007 order adopting the original procedural schedule.

The reply indicated that the Joint Applicants have now complied with the requests of the other parties and therefore, the motion is moot. The Commission will direct the moving parties to file a response indicating whether their motion has become moot in light of the reply filed and information received.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and Praxair, Inc., AG Processing, Inc., and Sedalia Industrial Energy

Users' Association shall file a response to the reply of Great Plains Energy Incorporated, Kansas City Power & Light Company, and Aquila, Inc., no later than March 20, 2008.

2. This order shall become effective on March 17, 2008.
