ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On March 6, 2019, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), filed a *Motion to Suspend Tariff Sheets* in File No. GO-2019-0255 pending the Commission's decisions in File No. GO-2019-0058 and File No. GO-2019-0059. On March 20, 2019, the Commission issued its *Report and Order* in File No. GO-2019-0058 and File No. GO-2019-0059. On March 29, 2019, Staff filed its *Staff Recommendation* in File No. GO-2019-0255, and on March 29, 2019, Spire Missouri, Inc. ("Spire") filed a *Motion for Expedited Treatment and Approval of Tariff on Less than 30 Days' Notice* ("Motion to Expedite") in all three files.¹ The Commission will take up the Motion to Expedite with respect to all three files together.² The Commission will Order Staff to file a recommendation in response to Spire's Motion to Expedite.

² "When pending actions involve related questions of law or fact, the commission may order a joint hearing of any or all the matters at issue, and may make other orders concerning cases before it to avoid unnecessary costs of delay." 4 CSR 240-2.110(3).

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation in response to Spire Missouri Inc.'s *Motion for Expedited Treatment and Approval of Tariff on Less than 30 Days' Notice* no later than noon on April 2, 2019.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.


