THIRD MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

)

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Company" or "Ameren Missouri"), and hereby files this Third Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule ("Motion"), as follows:

- 1. On August 8, 2023, the Commission adopted a procedural schedule and certain procedural items which had been agreed upon among the parties to this case.
- 2. On October 30, 2023, the Company submitted an unopposed motion seeking to amend the procedural schedule to extend the deadline for filing surrebuttal testimony due to medical issues experienced by one of the Company's main witnesses in this case, which had effectively prevented the witness from working, which included preventing the witness from preparing surrebuttal testimony in response to the rebuttal testimony of 14 Staff witnesses filed on October 11, 2023.¹ On November 1, 2023, the Commission amended the procedural schedule as requested and adjusted certain other then-existing deadlines and added one new procedural milestone.²

3. On November 6, 2023, the Company filed an additional unopposed motion seeking to suspend the then-in-effect procedural schedule in its entirety due to an additional hospitalization and ongoing medical issues of one of its main witnesses, which were continuing to prevent the

The Company sought an order that would provide certain clarifications respecting any such sur-surrebuttal testimony. The Commission clarified its order on November 17, 2023.

witness's ability to work, including to work on surrebuttal testimony. As indicated in that motion, the Company was unable at that time to assess the impact of the medical issues on the processing of this case.

4. The witness is no longer in the hospital and has returned to work with some limitations and is working to prepare surrebuttal testimony which in turn will allow the Company to complete other surrebuttal testimony, which is interdependent with the formerly absent witness's surrebuttal testimony.

5. On November 20, 2023, the Company emailed all parties the following procedural schedule milestones and deadlines to allow completion of the processing of this case:

6. All parties except the Staff have authorized the Company to advise the Commission

in this Motion that they are in agreement with or do not object to the above-proposal, with one exception, that is, instead of starting the hearings on February 12, 2024 (which is Lincoln's Birthday, which the Company had initially overlooked) the hearings would start on February 13 and continue through February 15, 2024.⁵

7. As the Company indicated it would do when it proposed this schedule, the Company will file its surrebuttal testimony on December 15, 2023. To ensure there are no additional delays in processing this case, the Company requests that the Commission adopt the amended schedule proposed in this Motion no later than its next Agenda, December 13, 2023. Doing so will allow any party that contends that any of the Company's surrebuttal is improper under the Commission's governing rule to file a motion as contemplated by the Commission's November 17, 2023 Order, and to do so prior to the commencement of the Christmas holiday, and it will allow the case to be processed as soon as reasonably possible under the circumstances.⁶ To summarize, with the revised hearing date the Company, with the agreement of all parties to this case except the Staff, requests that the following milestones and deadlines be established:
