**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO REPLACE INITIAL POST-HEARING BRIEF**

**COMES NOW** The Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC”), by and through counsel, moves the Commission for leave to replace its Initial Post-Hearing Brief filed today with the attached Initial Post-Hearing Brief to correct formatting and non-substantive errors.

1. The OPC originally filed its Initial Post-Hearing Brief at approximately 12:07 AM on December 7, 2023, as a result of unforeseen technical issues related to the OPC’s filing.

After originally filing OPC’s Initial Post-Hearing Brief, undersigned counsel realized that the OPC’s filed brief has some unresolved formatting issues including: Section titles in the Table of Contents not matching those titles in the body of the brief, missing and misformatted footnotes, and red font that should have been black. None of these corrections substantively affect the brief.

2. Undersigned counsel has corrected the formatting issues in the attached OPC’s Initial Post-Hearing Brief.

3. In seeking to replace the OPC’s original Initial Post-Hearing Brief, the OPC does not intend to cause either Public Service Commission Staff (“Staff”) or The

Raytown Water Company (“RWC” or “Company”) undue prejudice, but simply to correct the formatting errors contained in its originally filed brief.

**WHEREFORE**, the OPC respectfully requests the Commission grant this *Motion for Leave to Replace Post Hearing Brief*.
