On March 3, 2011, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, AG Processing, Inc., the Sedalia Industrial Energy Users' Association, and Dogwood Energy LLC, filed a joint motion for extension of time to file posthearing briefs. The requested extension is for briefs pertaining to only GMO and not regarding any issues heard in common with KCPL. The Commission has considered the motion and will grant it. Barring an extraordinary event constituting good cause, no further extensions of time will be granted in this case.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion for Extension of Time for Filing of Posthearing Briefs filed on March 3, 2011 is granted.
2. Initial posthearing briefs for the issues exclusive to the KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company in GR-2010-0356 shall be filed no later than March 25, 2011.
3. Reply briefs and proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law shall be filed no later than April 4, 2011.

4. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
