PROTECTIVE ORDER

On April 15, 2019, The Empire District Electric Company filed its 2018 Renewable Energy Standard (RES) Compliance Report and 2019 RES Compliance Plan. Empire filed portions of that Report and Plan as confidential, and other portions as highly confidential. Before filing the Report and Plan, Empire filed a motion on April 4, 2019, asking the Commission to issue a protective order seeking additional protection for certain commercially sensitive information regarding renewable energy certificate (REC) prices and payment terms. Empire seeks leave to designate that information as Highly Confidential as permitted by the Commission's confidential information rule, 4 CSR 240-2.135(4).

More than ten days have passed since Empire filed its motion and no party has objected to its request for a protective order.¹ The Commission will grant the request. The specific extra protections to be afforded to the information designated by Empire as highly confidential are described in this order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

Competitively sensitive information designated by The Empire District Electric
 Company as highly confidential shall be disclosed only to attorneys of record for all parties,

to state agency parties and their employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, and to designated outside experts of any non-state agency party.

- 2. Except for attorneys of record for all parties, and employees of state agency employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, all persons authorized to access "confidential" information in this case shall complete the nondisclosure agreement attached to this order as Exhibit A.
- 3. Except for attorneys of record for all parties, and employees of state agency employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, all persons authorized to access "highly confidential" information in this case shall complete the nondisclosure agreement attached to this order as Exhibit B.
- 4. Persons afforded access to materials or information designated "highly confidential" shall neither use nor disclose such materials or information for purposes of business or competition or any other purpose other than in regard to this case and shall keep the materials and information secure and confidential and in accordance with the purposes and intent of the protective order.
- 5. All material and information designated as "highly confidential" in the possession of any entity or persons, other than in the Commission's file, as well as any notes pertaining to such information, shall be returned to Empire or destroyed upon the conclusion of this case.
- 6. If a party disagrees with the "highly confidential" designation of any information, the party shall follow the informal discovery dispute resolution procedures set forth in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090(8). If the party exhausts those dispute resolution procedures, the party may file a motion challenging the designation.

7. This order shall be effective when issued.
