ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On April 15, 2019, The Empire District Electric Company filed its 2018 Renewable Energy Standard (RES) Compliance Report and 2019 RES Compliance Plan. Renew Missouri Advocates, d/b/a Renew Missouri, the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy, and Sierra Club filed separate applications to intervene on April 19.

More than ten days have passed since the applications to intervene were filed and no one has responded to those applications. After considering the unopposed applications to intervene, the Commission finds that allowing Renew Missouri, Division of Energy, and Sierra Club to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri's application to intervene is granted.
2. The Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy's application to intervene is granted.
3. Sierra Club's Motion to Intervene is granted.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
