## ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO AGREEMENT AS TO PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On November 2, 2010, most of the parties in Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's general rate increase case filed an agreement as to proposed procedural schedule, related procedural items, and test year true-up cut-off dates. The parties that joined in the agreement are Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, the Missouri Energy Group, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, AARP, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers and International Union of Operating Engineers Locals, the Midwest Energy Users Association, Consumers Council of Missouri, the Missouri Retailers Association, Charter Communications, Inc., and the Natural Resources Defense Council. However, not all parties joined in the agreement. The Missouri Coalition for the Environment, d/b/a Renew Missouri, The Municipal Group, and Missouri-American Water Company are not listed as proponents of the agreement.

The three parties who are not listed as proponents of the agreement did not file any counter-pleading regarding a proposed procedural schedule within the time established by the Commission and presumably, do not object to the agreement. However, before acting on the agreement, the Commission will allow those parties a brief time to respond.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Any party wishing to respond to the Agreement as to Proposed Procedural Schedule, Related Procedural Items, and Test Year True-Up Cut-Off Dates shall do so no later than November 4, 2010.
  - 2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
