**ORDER GRANTING MISSOURI INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS'
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE TESTIMONY OUT OF TIME**

On February 14, 2011, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) filed a motion seeking leave to file the testimony of two witnesses out of time. Under the established procedural schedule, MIEC should have filed that testimony on February 10, but MIEC was unable to file its testimony until the next business day because it was unable to access the Commission electronic filing system on the evening of February 10. MIEC did, however, serve a copy of its testimony on the other parties shortly after the midnight deadline. More than ten days have passed since MIEC filed its motion and no party has responded.

MIEC's brief delay in filing its testimony did not prejudice any party, and has not inconvenienced the Commission. The Commission will grant MIEC's motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers' Motion for Leave to File Testimony Out of Time is granted.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
