NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR FILINGS

The Missouri Public Service Commission is extending the time for filing an application for intervention and a response to the recommendation of staff.

Regulation 4 CSR 240-3.161(8), (9), and (10) provides that all parties to the rate action, in which the fuel adjustment clause at issue was established, are parties to this action and shall receive certain information. And both the application and Staff's recommendation include certifications of service to counsel of record for all parties. But the Commission's service list includes only persons in the offices of the applicant, the Commission's General Counsel, and the Office of the Public Counsel.

Therefore, in an abundance of caution, the Commission will issue this order to all parties to the rate action in which the fuel adjustment clause at issue was established. The Commission will also extend the deadline for intervention for persons not already parties. Further, the Commission extend the time for any response to the recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send this notice and order to all parties to the general rate action in file no. ER-2007-0004.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall add to the service list to all parties to the general rate action in file no. ER-2007-0004.
3. The Commission's Data Center shall send this notice and order to all members of the General Assembly serving persons within the service territories at issue.
4. Any application for intervention, and any response to the recommendation of the Commission's staff, shall be filed no later than February 10, 2011.
5. This order shall be effective immediately upon issuance.
