On February 12, 2019, Elm Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc. ("Elm Hills"), filed an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity with the Public Service Commission ("Commission"). The Commission ordered the Staff of the Commission ("Staff") to file a recommendation no later than April 15, which was extended to May 20, following a joint motion from the parties.

On April 26, Elm Hills, Staff, and the City of Sedalia filed a joint motion requesting a further extension of time in which to complete discovery and discussions concerning the application. The parties requested an extension for submission of Staff's recommendation from May 20 to June 20. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) states that parties have ten days to respond to pleadings unless otherwise ordered. Ten days have elapsed since filing of the joint motion for further extension of time. No party has objected to the request.

The Commission appreciates the timely request for extension. The Commission finds that the joint request for further extension is reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Joint Motion for Further Extension of Time to File Recommendation filed jointly by Elm Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc., Staff, and the City of Sedalia on April 26, 2019, is granted.
 - 2. Staff shall file its recommendation no later than June 20, 2019.
- 3. Any responses to Staff's recommendation shall be filed no later than June 30, 2019.
 - 4. This order shall be effective when issued.
