## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On April 12, 2019, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application asking the Commission to cancel the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity granted to Ameren Missouri in 2005 applicable to the property formerly occupied by the aluminum smelter owned by Noranda and now occupied by the aluminum smelter owned by Magnitude 7 Metals, LLC. Ameren Missouri also asked the Commission to cancel its Large Transmission Service (LTS) rate schedule under which Noranda was the only qualifying customer. The Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) applied to intervene on May 2.

More than ten days have passed since the application to intervene was filed and no one has responded to that application. After considering the unopposed application to intervene, the Commission finds that allowing MIEC to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application to intervene of the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers is granted.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.


