ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE, AND SCHEDULING A PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

On May 15, 2019, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to section 393.170, RSMo 2016. The CCN would authorize Ameren Missouri to construct, own, and operate a wind generation facility to be constructed in Atchison County, Missouri. Ameren Missouri requests the Commission grant it a CCN no later than October 10, 2019.

The Commission will provide notice of the application to the general public and interested parties and set a deadline for intervention requests. If no movant is granted intervention, and neither the Commission's Staff nor the Office of the Public Counsel requests a hearing, the Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary for a determination of the application. In addition, the Commission will schedule a procedural conference for May 30. The Commission will take up the procedural schedule proposed by Ameren Missouri as well as the company's motion for a protective order at the

- The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Atchison County, Missouri.
- 2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the Missouri General Assembly representing Atchison County, Missouri and to the media serving that county.
- 3. The Commission's data center shall provide a copy of this order to every party to Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's prior wind generation certificate of convenience and necessity cases, File Number EA-2018-0202 and File Number EA-2019-0021, the High Prairie and Brickyard Hills wind generation facilities, respectively.
- 4. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than May 25, 2019. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System ("EFIS") or with the Secretary of the Commission.
- 5. A procedural conference is scheduled for May 30, 2019, beginning at 10:00 a.m. The conference will be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 305, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
